Project name: Spitskop Wind Energy Facility

Applicant: Renewable Energy Systems Southern Africa ('RES Southern Africa')

Proposed Activity: The establishment of a wind energy facility and associated infrastructure within a broader site of 264 km² located approximately 6km north-west of Riebeeck East and ~15km north-west of Alicedale in the Eastern Cape Province. The proposed facility would have a generating capacity of up to 420 MW (depending on the choice of turbine) and the following associated infrastructure:

- » Wind turbines (between 80m – 120m hub height) and foundations may be concrete or rock anchor to support them.
- » Cabling between the turbines, to be laid underground where practical.
- » Internal access roads to each turbine.
- » Workshop area for control, maintenance and storage.
- » On-site substation/s to facilitate the connection between the wind energy facility and the grid.
- » New overhead power line/s likely to be connected to Eskom's existing Poseidon Substation near Cookhouse

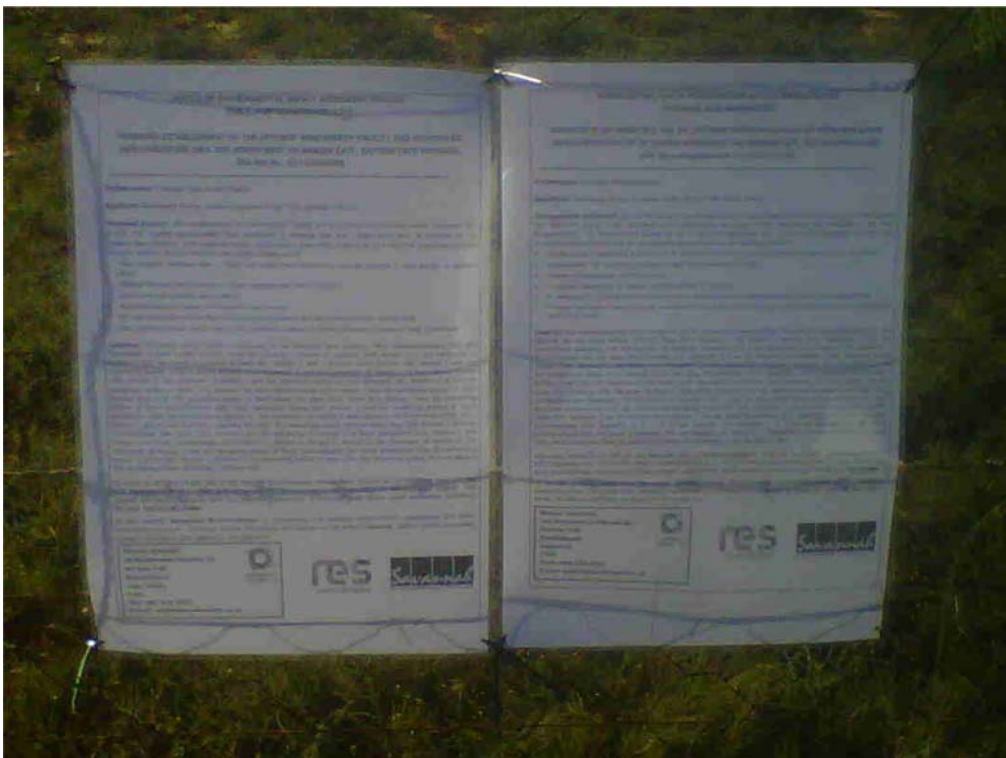

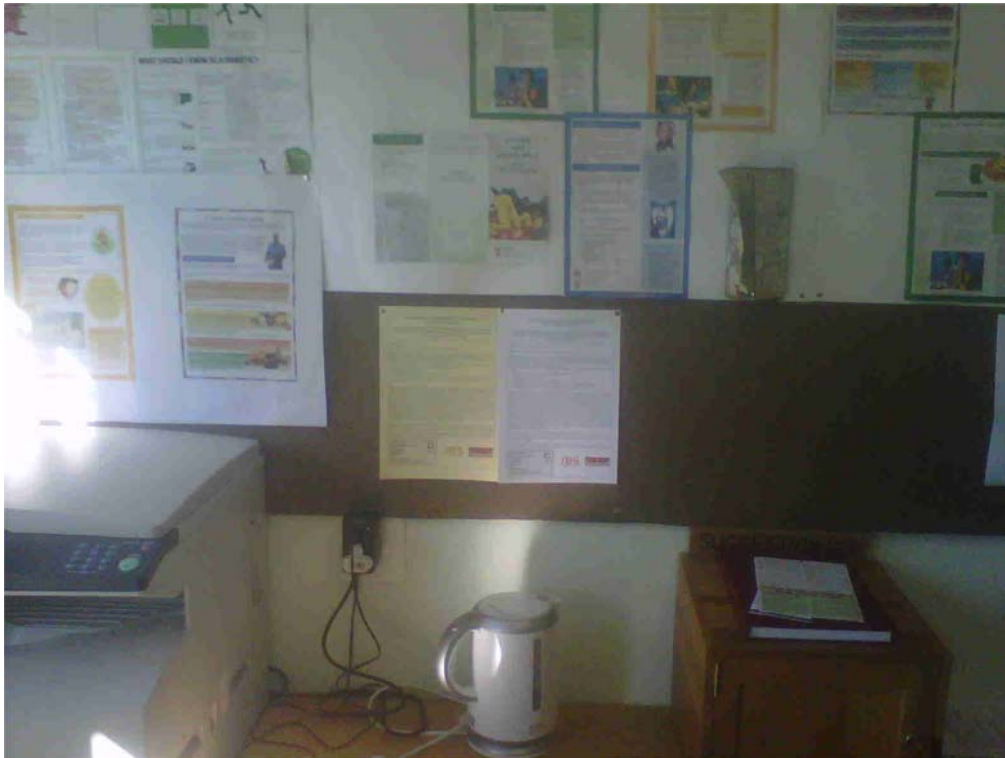

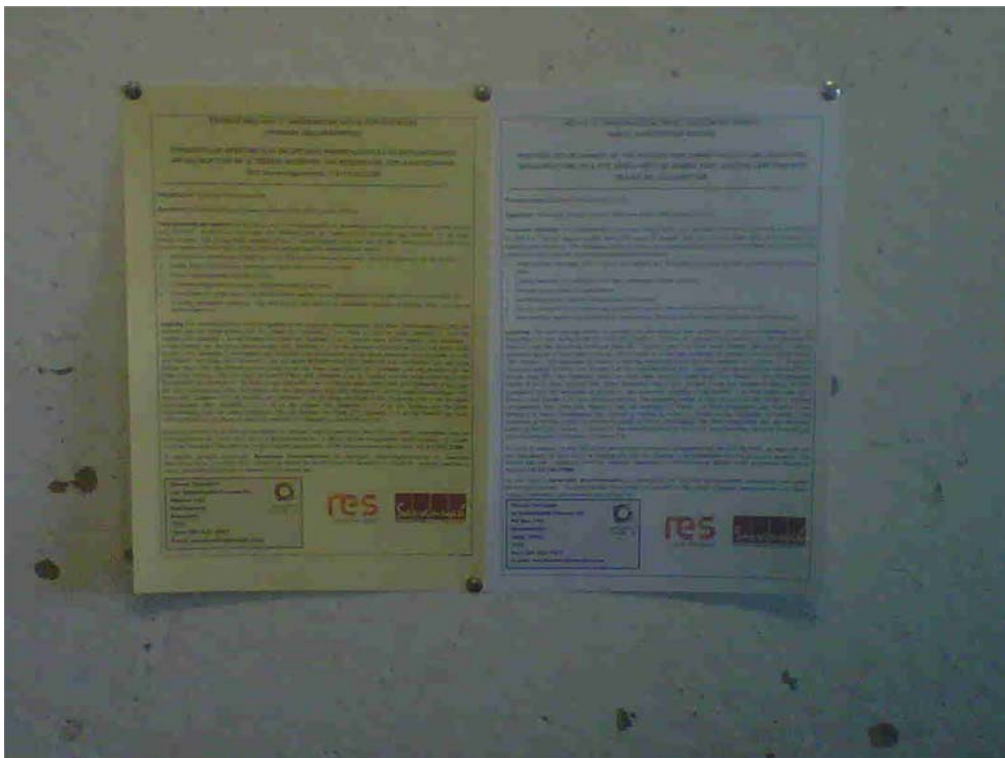
Site notice placed at N10 and R400 road crossing on Farm Commadagga 266

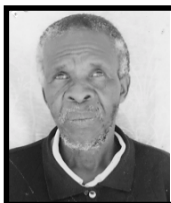

National Arts Festival, Grahamstown: Answer to Winter Holiday Plans

South Africa's biggest, longest running and most diverse annual arts celebration is gearing up for its 37th season in Grahamstown to take place from 30 June – 10 July 2011. The National Arts Festival has an international reputation for being South Africa's premiere arts celebration that showcases the best of South African exhibitions and performances in theatre, music, dance and other art forms. The highlights of the Festival will undoubtedly be showcased in its Main programme featuring the imaginatively creative geniuses of the 2011 Standard Bank Young Artist Award winners: Ben Schoeman (Music), Neil Coppen (Drama), Nandipha Mntambo (Visual Art), Mamelela Nyamza (Dance) and Bokani Dyer (Jazz). With the Fringe registration deadline closed a barely a few weeks ago, the Fringe Festival has commenced with scheduling more than 280 cutting edge South African productions and at least 10 productions registered from the rest of Africa and Europe. A number of winning producers of last year's inaugural Standard Bank Fringe Ovation Award will be premiering new works on the Festival's Arena programme. The Arena programme, launched in 2010 is an invitation-based bridge for artists between the finely selected Main programme and the open-access and eclectic Fringe programme. Street theatre productions and visual art presentations in public spaces will once again create a city-wide Festival buzz in Grahamstown and its surrounding areas. A BRIEF REPORT ON ITHEMBA FOUNDATION'S ACTIVITIES

SOMERSET EAST

The following is a brief report on Ithemba Foundation's activities and involvement in the communities. For the past years Ithemba Foundation provides food parcels to the needy families in the different denominations in our town. Currently we provide 60-70 food parcels per month to needy families from fourteen congregations. These food parcels are issued on a fortnightly basis.

SCHOOLS

Ithemba Foundation also reaches out to the schools in town. In February we purchased clothes and shoes for seven needy learners at Nojoli Senior Primary School and in May this year we bought school uniforms for five learners at Gilbert Xuzza Junior School. For some time Ithemba Foundation arranged for bread and jam to be delivered at W.G. Olivier Primary School and Nonzwakazi School and when we learned that these are the only schools in town that do not benefit from the Education Department's feeding scheme, we decided that arrangements be made to provide three cooked meals for three days per week for the needy 154 learners at W.G. Olivier School and the 257 learners at Nonzwakazi School for three months. This project commenced on Monday 20 June 2011.

On 6 June 2011, 992 tooth brushes, 72 tubes of tooth paste, 176 small combs and 30 boxes of men's tissues which we received as donations, were distributed among six primary schools and two crèches.

BLANKETS

During the month of June Ithemba Foundation supplied ten blankets and five food parcels to Social Development, cleaning material and toiletries to Child Welfare and five denominations each received ten blankets to be distributed among needy families. Arrangements are also being made to provide the ingredients for soup to the ACVV for the needy families at Aeroville. We also collect and receive secondhand clothes which we distribute in town and on some of our neighbouring farms. Ithemba Foundation wishes to express its sincere gratitude to our donors who make it possible for us to help others in need.
